



RESERVA MERLOT

Tasting Notes

Part of this wine has been aged for 10 months in American and French oak barrels. Perfectly balanced, this red cherry wine has an elegant aroma, with black fruit, cinnamon and coffee notes. In the mouth it is creamy, with soft tannins and long persistence. Excellent with pastas and all kind of meat dishes.



Grape Variety: Merlot.



Region of Origin: Colchagua Valley.



Soil: Average depth, clay loam with drip irrigation.



Altitude: 250 m a. s. l.



Climate: Dry and continental with great sun exposure allowing perfect ripening.



Vine cultivation: Vertical shoot position trellising.



Harvest Detail: 3rd and 4th week of April.



Alcohol content: 13.5 % v/v
